

Protocol is a critical part of Wei Wai Kum culture and one of the foundations of managing marine resources throughout our Territory. The fundamental concepts of our protocol include: acknowledging that you are in Wei Wai Kum Territory; asking permission to use Wei Wai Kum marine resources; and sharing in the benefits from using Wei Wai Kum resources.

#### Wei Wai Kum Protocol Procedures:

1. Acknowledgement of our Aboriginal Rights and Title in our territory (be respectful when visiting our territory and understand the importance of this area to the Wei Wai Kum Nation).
2. If you plan on taking resources or benefitting from our territory you will need Wei Wai Kum consent (contact our Band office to set up a meeting with Chief & Council).

We require respect for the abundance and diversity of life within our Territory which is a part of the Wei Wai Kum management approach. We are the stewards and owners of our Territory and those already operating or planning to operate in our Territory must demonstrate a respect for Wei Wai Kum's Aboriginal Rights and Title, culture and stewardship.
